Success Story

HOWEVER, DUE TO THE DAUGHTER ENABLING THE TRACKING DEVICE VIA HER CELL PHONE, CSS TOGETHER WITH THE EAST RAND K9 UNIT WERE ABLE TO LOCATE & RECOVER THE VEHICLE. 1 SUSPECT WAS SHOT AND KILLED AND UNFORTUNATELY THE VEHICLE WAS RETURNED WITH BULLET HOLES..... THE GOOD THING IS THESE SUSPECTS KNOW NOT TO COME INTO SONNEGLANS !!! THEY COULD BE CAUGHT (AND MOSTLY ARE). THIS IS THE 1ST HI-JACKING THAT SONNEGLANS HAS HAD IN THE ALMOST 4 YEARS THAT CSS HAS BEEN LOOKING AFTER THE AREA.

1 House Breaking 1Medical Emergency

Streets that were affected by crime in the Welridge & Riverwel area : Wonderboom Street, Mispel Street, Wildebraam Street x 2, Appelblaar, Dolfhout, Cockspur, Amarant, Sycamore Street

There was an attempted housebreaking in Huilbos. The suspects tried to break the back door however the alarm activated and the suspects ran off. This happened at 03h00! Goes to show arm your alarms – it does help !! There are still residents that do not arm their alarms or are not linked to an armed response company ☹. 1 Housebreaking, 1 Hijacking

The house breaking occurred at The Reeds Complex on Ella Street. The suspects gained entrance from the greenbelt side. The perimeter palisade fence was cut and the electric fence was lifted. They broke the burglar proofing of the unit. Many electrical appliances together with a douvet was stolen.

There was an incident that CSS was called out by a resident who is a member of CSS and pressed his panic button due to the fact that he could hear people outside fighting. CSS got the police to sort it out.

Please remember again that Bromhof is a huge area and only incidents which are reported to us to attend to, do we know about. However from our reports, things are very quiet, but let us not get complacent.

LINDEN PRECINCT:

MALANSHOF, MORET, FONTAINBLEAU, RUITERHOF

2 x Housebreaking of which 1 was a success! ☺ 1x Driveway Robbery

Streets that were affected by the crime: Silverpine Avenue, Martha Rd North, Kasper Street

With regards to the driveway robbery: A visitor of the resident in Kasper Street was getting ready to leave and they were at the car when they were approached by 2 armed B/M who got out of a vehicle – Ford Focus . They took cellphone, jewellery etc.

There was also a body of a man believed to be about 40 years old found lying dead at the corner of Silverpine & Hans Schoeman. Randburg Forensics took the body to the Mortuary.

There were also 2 medical emergencies : The gardener of Abelia Complex was up a ladder cutting a tree when he fell onto the palisade fence. ER24 was called and took him to Olivedale Hospital. Then there were vagrants fighting on the 28th July. One was stabbed on the left hand side. The police and ER24 was called and the stabbed victim was seen to by ER24 and the other vagrant was arrested by the police.

There was also an incident reported on the 1st July where runners from the Randburg Sports Club were running in the early hours of the morning and were attacked by 2 W/M. They were chased by CSS when they were called.

SUCCESS STORY: The fact that crime has is still on the decrease with regards to reports given to CSS where they were called out, is success in itself !

However there is a good success story here ☺ **ON THE 10TH JULY AT 19H20 A RESIDENT FROM MARTHA RD NORTH THE HOMEOWNER ON HIS RETURN HOME SAW A SUSPECT IN HIS PROPERTY WHO WAS BUSY BREAKING IN AND CALLED US. THE SUSPECT STARTED TO RUN AWAY, HOWEVER THE HOMEOWNER CHASED HIM AND CAUGHT HIM AND MANAGED TO HOLD HIM UNTIL WE WERE ABLE TO CUFF HIM. LINDEN SAPS ARRIVED AND ARRESTED HIM FOR HOUSE BREAKING. ☺**

Feedback on the vagrant problem that was at the corner of Hans Schoeman and Silverpine, it seems that Linden SAPS have dealt with the issue. We have not seen the vagrants there anymore. Thank you to Linden SAPS and to all of the parties involved with getting rid of them.
