Success Story: ☺ The Housebreaking & theft was not a successful one for the suspects. They were seen by the Trojan reaction officer who was reacting to the alarm. The defeating of the ends of justice: This is terrible. Our reaction officer was stopped on Jim Fouche by a lady who advised she had been hijacked and needed a lift to her premises in Willowview. The hijacking went on the groups to be on the lookout for the supposed vehicle that was hijacked. It was then discovered by our senior officer and the Caltex garage that this lady was well known for this kind of scam to get a lift. The number she had provided was incorrect and therefore we could not trace her...
