Success Stories



Weltevredenpark - 4 B/Ms were seen walking with stolen cable at 08h35 on the N1 highway behind Wesbank. Lawrence found their sleeping place and destroyed it.

Sonneglans - Whilst patrolling in Harry Sneeck, Mpumelelo spotted a wanted VW Caddy and a chase began involving many of the CSS vehicles, together with assistance from other security companies. Finally the vehicle stopped in Soweto at New Canada and Buffalo Roads but the 2 B/Ms jumped and ran into the veld. They left the vehicle together with 2 cell phones, a knife and the vehicle keys. The vehicle was towed by SAPS to the police pound. It was also discovered that the VW had a false registration plate.

Malanshof – there was an incident at a Trojan client in Gertrude Street : 3B/Ms breached the palisade fence and entered the home, tied up the domestic and had the TV and stolen goods at the exit door ready to go. The neighbour called into our office and advised suspicious activity. Unfortunately for them, our CSS team was too quick. CSS chased the suspects and David managed to catch and arrest 1 of them on Monkor Road. Their getaway vehicle was also left outside the property in Gertrude Street . WELL DONE to the neighbour who responded to the screams...

HONEYDEW PRECINCT:

RANDPARKRIDGE (RRVA area):

1 Street Robbery – Anaboom at the dam. 1 Theft – Asgaai. 1 Robbery – Essenhout. 3 House Robberies – Seder, Olienhout, Hibiscus, The battery to the cell phone tower in Essenhout on the 2nd Nov was stolen during the night.

On the 2nd November at 09h07 a, CSS patrol vehicle noticed that 2 men in a white golf travelling along RP Drive. It was followed into a complex and the response officer tailgated the vehicle. When they noticed they were being followed they made a U turn and drove back out of the complex as the gate was left open and left the area.

At another complex in RPR on the 2nd November, during the morning the gate beam had been cut. Suspects were in a white VW caddy – JJZ889GP.

At a house in Mopani Street , beams were activated and 2 B/M were seen on the premises but when CSS searched the property they found nothing.

In Olienhout our officer – Oriel found the driveway gate open and he made contact with the client via the intercom and they closed it.

COMPLEXES:

HEATHER Complex - had the attempted break in.

BUSHILL Complex – Unknown suspects breached the electric fence by digging under it. They broke a garage door to one of the units and stole a laptop and computer.

Harrowood Complex : On the 2nd November at 09h00, 5 B/M's posing as contractors were in a home and one drew a gun and assaulted the home owner and stole his gold chain around his neck. The victim was taken to hospital by ambulance.

Other : Information via the What's App group was given that there was an apparent dog poisoning but CSS could not gather any further information. There was a MVA in Palmiet Street. On the 30th November our reaction officer found a lady outside her gate in Hyacinth Street at 01h44 who was struggling to open her garage door. Our vehicle assisted the lady but while moving her car into the garage, she rolled back and damaged the front bumper of the CSS vehicle.

Happy to advise, no incidents were reported with regards to residential homes ☺ !!! Remember do not be complacent, instead step up your vigilance. Keep your security tight and call if you see anything suspicious. Theft of petrol was reported on the 13th November at 02h31 at the Engen Garage, a W/M driving a white Ford Ranger filled up with fuel but when it came to pay, he took out a credit card and driver's license which belonged to his wife. He swore at the petrol attendant and drove off. Unfortunately the vehicle had no registration number plates but Help24 was printed on both sides of the vehicle. The value of fuel was R 163.70.
