2015 – What To Expect

We expect an increase in crime this year as we have in the previous years but with an added aggression.

We are experiencing increased Vagrant type crime, Street Robberies, Smash & Grabs, and house breakings/Robberies. These criminals are not organized and are mostly opportunistic. They target individuals who are not vigilant and homes with easy access.

Our concern is that the Vagrant type person is usually under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. To add to this, they have very little or nothing to live for and will not hesitate to attack or use a weapon to achieve their goal. They are not confident in what they are out to achieve which escalates the incident if it doesn't go according to their expectations. Their weapons are usually a knife or screw driver and only occasionally a firearm.

The organized criminal is trained in what he does and he has a plan. He is confident and does not normally use force if allowed to achieve his goal.

Our Vagrant type criminal is not easy to catch as he is on foot and has no hesitation in jumping over electric fences, high walls, etc, where our Security Officers and Police in full battle dress are unable to go. He wears dark clothing at night and can camouflage himself in the shadows.

Walk in groups of two or more if you have to be in the Street. Arm your Alarms and perimeter protection when you are not at home and at night when you are asleep. Remain vigilant when driving your car alone and keep an eye out for suspicious persons at robots or in heavy traffic.

Success Story

1. Area specific incidents

HONEYDEW PRECINCT:

RANDPARKRIDGE - Ouhout Place : Suspects rang the intercom and advised the domestic they are coming to view the house (it was for sale). 1B/M & 4 B/F's entered the property and whilst 'viewing' stole cell phones, jewellery, I pad, & tablets. They were driving a silver/ gold Nissan X-Trail .

Asgaai : Vehicle broken into which was parked on the verge. No items taken.

Katdoring Street : VW Caddy stolen off the verge.

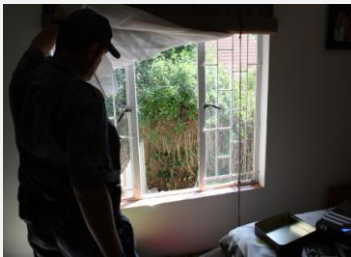
Essenhout : Suspects jumped the wall and broke into a vehicle that was parked in the driveway.

Suikerbos : 2 B/M jumped the gate, broke the burglar proofing . TV & video games stolen. Alarm not armed.

Suikerbos: 2 B/M Trellis gate cut & opened slider. TV, I-pad and laptop stolen.

Privet: 2B/M jumped wall & broke burglar proofing TV, I Pad, & Lap top stolen **HOWEVER** suspects were spotted and chased by CSS staff members Lawrence & Oriël who recovered the items.(See success stories)

Klapperboom : Burglar bars broken & laptop stolen.



WELTEVREDENPARK

RIVERWEL :

Amarant Str : 3 coloured men attempted to break in. Main gate was breached – back door broken but suspects seen and were chased.

Saffraan: 2 C/M's + 2 B/M's entered the house via the open gate with handguns. TV's & electronic equipment stolen.

Without : 3 B/M in a silver Opel Corsa – nothing stolen.

Wildebraam : Suspect jumped wall, held up domestic with a screwdriver T.V. & duvet stolen.

WELRIDGE :

Rooihout : Suspects jumped wall and broke burglar proofing. Memory stick & documents recovered.

Sycamore : Suspects jumped the wall and broke burglar proofing. Handbag stolen.

Cockspur : Burglar proofing cut but due to the fact that the alarm was on, it activated and scared them off.

Weltevreden Spar : At around 7pm, 10 suspects walked in and held up staff and shoppers and stole R15 000.

SONNEGLANS - No crime to report .See picture for flooding of Nyala Road from Pampoen Spruit on 3 January 😊



BROMHOF – Pelikaan Street : Suspects entered house via the open door. Held resident at knife point. Stole jewellery off the resident's fingers, cash as well as cellphone.

WITH REGARDS TO THE CRIME IN OUR HONEYDEW SECTOR, PLEASE NOTE THAT THROUGHOUT THE HONEYDEW PRECINCT , OVER 200 HOUSE BREAKINGS WERE REPORTED IN JANUARY, OUR STATISTICS, WHILST UNACCEPTABLE, ARE SIGNIFICANTLY LOWER THAN OUR SURROUNDING NEIGHBOURHOODS. To minimize crime in your area, please be extra vigilant, put your alarms on even when you are home, especially at night time! Make sure your alarms are working. If you cannot for whatever reason afford the alarm link up then at least join your Residents Association, you will receive the number for the standby/ patrolling vehicle. Or for the areas that it applies to, join the safety and security package. Lock doors. Do not leave cars unlocked or items on the seats for the roving eye. If possible always park your cars behind gates not on verges. When locking vehicles at shopping centres, always manually check your car is locked. If you have vehicles parking on your verge unavoidably, organize a car guard not just extra patrols. Most of all network and communicate information and REPORT anything suspicious.

LINDEN PRECINCT:

MALANSHOF - Elise Rd : Access via neighbour's wall. Laptop stolen
Silverpine : Lawnmower stolen off the verge. A brown 1400 bakkie seen.
Annie Rd : Main gate breached & broke front door. Laptop & I Pad stolen.
Sunrise Supermarket : 1 B/M walked in when owner opened. Hit owner on the head and stole cigarettes.

LINDEN SECTOR 3 - Winston Avenue : Suspect climbed over the wall & a bicycle was stolen.

COMPLEXES - A domestic was followed into the complex through the main gate. Both the domestic and gardener were tied up. Many items were stolen.

WITH REGARDS TO THE CRIME OVERVIEW IN MALANSHOF, FONTAINBLEAU, RUITERHOF, MORET AND SECTOR 3 – COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES HAS BEEN OPERATIONAL IN THE AREA SINCE 2013 WITH A SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT IN CRIME STATS. VOSLOO STREET IS NOT EVEN MENTIONED ABOVE AS THERE WERE NO INCIDENTS TO REPORT AND THEY USED TO HAVE HUGE AMOUNT OF CRIME.
