HONEYDEW PRECINCT:

RANDPARKRIDGE:

3 House Breakings 2 Theft out of motor vehicles 1 Theft 1 Hi-jacking

Streets that were affected by crime in Randparkridge :

Enkeldoring Str x 2, Frangipani, Seder Rd, Essenhout Dr, Randpark Drive, Rosyntjebos Str

The theft out of motor vehicles. The vehicles were parked in the driveways behind locked gates but there is no perimeter security protecting the boundary walls or the garden area. The suspects did not enter the houses.

The 1 x theft. Access was gained via the wall from Rabie Street and 2 plastic chairs were stolen. The hijacking that occurred on the 27th June at 13h10 – the couple were followed by a white BMW from Randridge Mall. The Toyota and cash was taken.

The Toyota was later recovered 😊.

RPRCPA:

1 House Breaking 1 Domestic Violence

Streets that were affected by incidents : Sambreelboom & Karee

The main gate was breached and front door broken and access gained. The resident had cancelled with his security provider 2 weeks prior and the alarm was not activated.

WELTEVREDENPARK:

2 House Breakings 3 Attempted House breakings 1 Theft out of motor vehicle 1 House breaking turned into armed robbery.

Streets that were affected by crime in the Welridge & Riverwel area : Wilderbraam Street, Harebell, Korhaan Street x 2, Wonderboom x 3, Corkbush.

Attempted house breakings did not occur due to alarms being activated....

Unfortunately the house breaking that turned into an armed robbery was an incident where the suspects breached the main gate and broke the front door. The domestic did see them and pressed her panic button which was audible and they left. Shortly thereafter they returned as there was no sign of any reaction company receiving the alarm signal. They then came back when the siren stopped going and held up the domestic and stole many electrical items.

SONNEGLANS:

The only incidents that we are aware of in our area is 2 separate incidents of wall hoppers that were reported on the 26 June. In Maryna Crescent a B/M was seen by a neighbour in the back garden of his neighbour. Called CSS but on arrival everything in and around the house was check and no one was found and nothing was seen to be stolen. The second incident was in Harry Sneece where a resident saw 3 B/M jumping into one of the neighbours garden and CSS was called. Once again, no one was found and all around was checked and nothing was stolen from any of the properties. 😊

BROMHOF:

1 Armed Robbery –

The armed robbery in Tin Road – (Non member)

Please remember that Bromhof is a huge area and only incidents which are reported to us to attend to, do we know about. However from our reports, things are very quiet, but let us not get complacent.

NORTHWOLD / APPLETREE LANE COMPLEX

1 Attempted House breaking

Sliding door to one of the units was damaged by what seems to be by someone trying to break in after they bent the security gate, no entry gained, nothing stolen.

LINDEN PRECINCT:

MALANSHOF, MORET, FONTAINBLEAU, RUITERHOF

1 x Street Robbery 2 x Attempted house breakings (Suspect in vehicle who allegedly stole cell phones was apprehended. Police were called and took over.)

Streets that were affected by the crime: Sasol Garage, Annie Road, Monkor Drive

At Sasol garage, a vagrant went into the change room and stole a jacket and ran off. CSS chased him and eventually he dropped the jacket and ran off. He managed to get away but the jacket was returned.

Regarding the attempted breakings, one incident the resident came home to find a suspect tampering with the driveway gate. When seen, he ran off. The other incident, it seems they may have been interrupted whilst trying to breach the gate as they did not enter the property.
