3 x House Breakings,

Streets affected by the incidents: Saffraan, Pecan Place, Witels
This month there were 4 gates that were left open. The residents of these premises were notified and gates were then closed. Please residents, you are setting yourself up as a soft target for the criminals. Our reaction officer came across an alarm activating in Sycamore – a Best Secure client but our reaction officer stopped to make sure that all was in order.
One of our operations managers, found an old lady sleeping in the garden of a property in Cockspur. She use to work in Wonderboom but was retrenched in February and she had no money or way of getting home to Newcastle. Honeydew SAPS took her to the police station to see if they could help her to get home.

SONNEGLANS:

1 Attempted driveway robbery and sadly 1 murder, 1 attempted break in, 2 medical emergencies

The attempted driveway robbery was in Harry Sneech. The murder, which I am sure everyone is aware, was in Witdoring. The attempted break in was in Ella. There was a hit and run incident on Nyala Street, by a resident of Alpine village who fled the scene. The male was taken to Helen Joseph and was treated there.

As you are aware there was a break in yesterday and that will reflect in the June stats.

Sadly the incident in Witdoring Street was really tragic and I hope that residents have taken a lesson from this and that is DO NOT employ casual labourers from the side of the road. On behalf of Community Support Services, we offer our sincere condolences to Dieter and the family on the terrible loss of Louisa.

Please remember that incidents that CSS is not notified of or called out to, will not be on the monthly report. So far the fact that there are attempts and as crazy as it sounds it shows that residents are being vigilant and aware and networking which scares the guys off so keep it up. This was reflected in another attempted incident in Witdoring when a domestic was working away and saw a B/M looking through the window, she screamed and phoned. Criminals hate an organized community.

BROMHOF:

1 Medical Emergency, 1 Business Robbery, 1 MI2P & pointing of firearm 1 Housebreaking

With regards to the business robbery: 3 B/M's with handguns robbed the tellers of cash from the tills. They were driving a blue Toyota corolla; unfortunately we could not get a registration plate.
