Whatsapp groups, facebook, twitter, etc, seem to be the new communication or information medium for communities and streets.

We (as in Security companies, tracker companies, Police, EMS, etc) have been using these tools for a few years now) with great success, allowing for quicker response to incidents, quick distribution for lookouts and help required. These groups are strictly controlled and members have to be vetted to be on the groups. No unnecessary communication is allowed and only relevant emergency information, lookouts are posted.

The extension of this is to have community and street groups for information and lookouts to assist the Security companies and emergency services. This I believe to be a positive step in the right direction if the rules are followed, allowing for many eyes and ears to help prevent crime and react to emergency situations.

Unfortunately many people have not been privileged to this crime information and communities are now traumatized by the amount of crime information which they now have first hand information to.

Be assured that the crime today is very similar to the crime 4 or so years ago, communities were just not aware. Members of these groups need to remain focused on the information at hand and not post their own concerns or feeling and incidents they may have encountered, which may be totally in appropriate and detract from the initial important post. Whatsapp administrators need to be very strict with this and remove anyone who doesn't comply with the rules.
