On the 22nd & 23rd Oct we experienced storms and trees fell over into streets. The CSS Pro Active team did a Sunday Tree cutting session to open the roads and was very successful in achieving this ☺...

Residents, please we urge you, we know the weather is at a phenomenal heat and people are enjoying the outdoors. We urge you to put your perimeter security on (beams). Make sure your electric fence is working and cut back the foliage on a regular basis. If you are entertaining outside first and foremost, make sure your gate is closed. Incidents are now occurring where residents are having a party, leave the front gate and doors open and opportunists see this, walk in and help themselves (unseen) and walk out and residents only notice things missing later or even as late as the following day thus making this a theft. (Not a break in or robbery). Basic procedures which just need to be followed to ensure the safety of your home.

SONNEGLANS:

Happy to advice, no incidents have been reported! Remember not to be complacent instead step up on your vigilance. Keep your security tight and call if you see anything suspicious.

BROMHOF/BOSKRUIJN:
